Brighton hosts various possibilities for accommodation such as flats, shared houses, bedsits or part-board with a host family. However, good accommodation is in demand due to the fact that Brighton is a student city and also a sought after area by the sea.

An average price guide:

Bed & breakfast	£25-£30+ per person per night
Bedsits	£75+ per person per week
Flats / house share	£80+ per person per week
Part board with family	£100+ per week, inc bed, breakfast and dinner

Please note that these prices are not including bills and are only a guide. You will be asked for rent in advance and a deposit.

Brighton is a University City and as such has a heavy demand on it for student rooms. I can advise you to get in as early as possible to find a place which suits your needs.
